Budget workshop scheduled for March 28th, 2025 from 11 am to 3pm

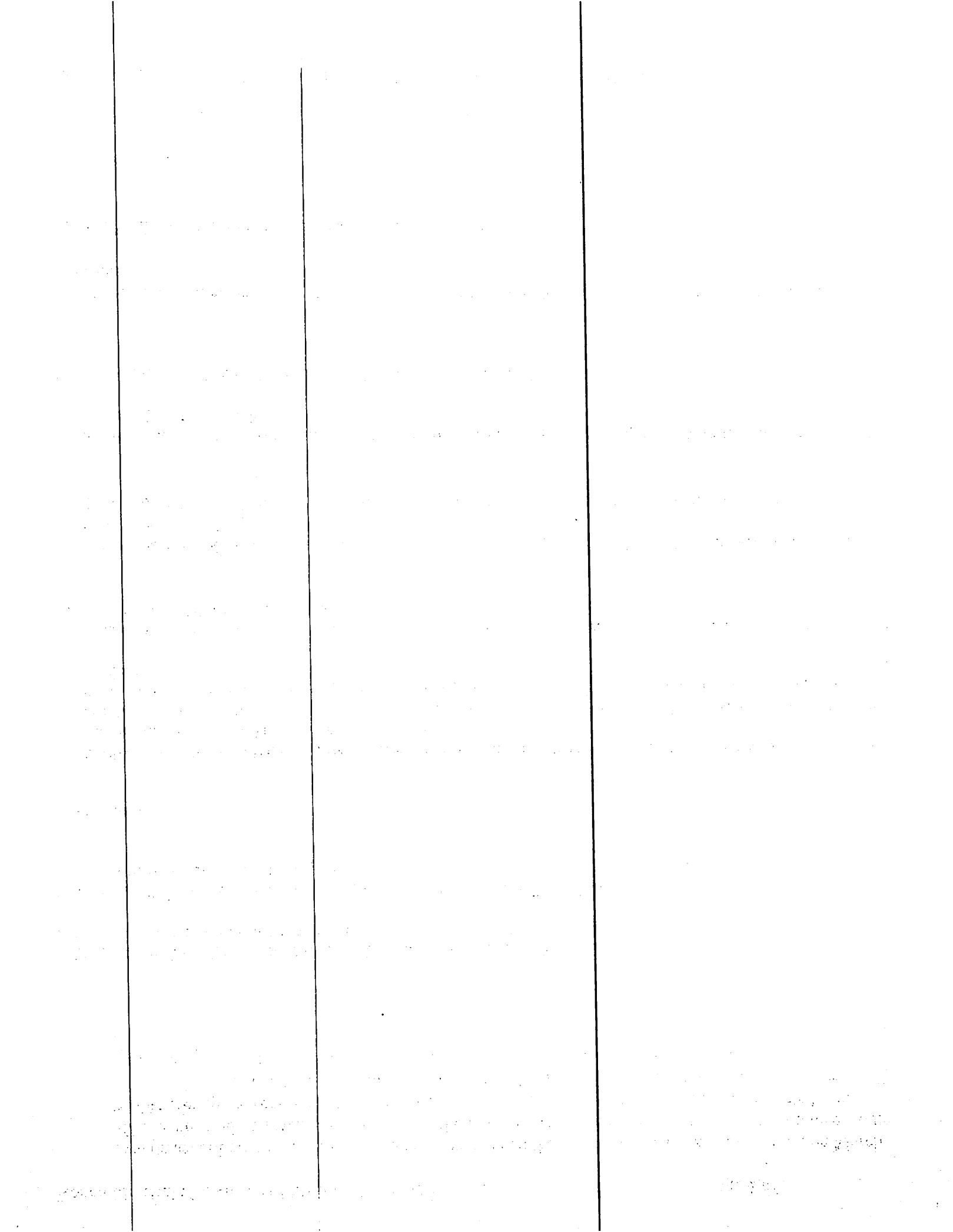
