Andrea Madziarek disclosed this year and the previous year. The county had a number input issue affecting tax returns/budget. This directed the library to be in a negative area with funds. Madziarek mentioned they're almost at \$25,000 due to donations. Madziarek is currently speaking and trusting the auditor to pursue correction of the unfortunate occurrence. James Swigart expressed the option to make the hardship a public hearing. Madziarek is very thankful for the town and doing her best to raise the extra money needed. event. Maintenance crew will be on hand for additional assistance. New scoreboard has been installed on the North Field. Additional scoreboards will be scheduled after 4<sup>th</sup> of July. The arcade added a fooseball to excite the rest of the fun being had.
