ORDINANCE NO. 3

SUMMARY: AN ORDINANCE ENACTING TRAFFIC REGULATIONS WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED TOWN OF ROUND MOUNTAIN, COUNTY OF NYE, STATE OF NEVADA, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF, AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING CHAPTER 484 OF N.R.S. BY REFERENCE, PURSUANT TO N.R.S. 484.777, ENTITLED TRAFFIC LAWS, WITH RESPECT TO THE STREETS AND ALLEYS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE UNINCORPORATED TOWN OF ROUND MOUNTAIN, COUNTY OF NYE, STATE OF NEVADA; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF; ESTABLISHING THE JURISDICTION OF THE JUSTICE OF THE PEACE; PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION AND DISTRIBUTION OF FINES AND FEES; PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTITUTIONALITY, SEVERABILITY, REPEAL AND EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO.

WHEREAS, NRS 269.185 confers the power and authority upon the Town Board of the unincorporated Town of Round Mountain, County of Nye, State of Nevada, to pass and adopt ordinances, to regulate traffic upon the streets and alleys and to regulate the speed, parking, stopping, turning and operation of all motor vehicles and other vehicles using the streets and alleys of the town, and

WHEREAS, NRS 484.777, unless otherwise provided by specific statute, enables the Town Board of the unincorporated town of Round Mountain, County of Nye, State of Nevada, to

enact, by ordinance, traffic regulations which cover the same subject matter as the various sections of Chapter 484 of NRS if the provisions of the ordinance do not conflict with that chapter,

NOW THEREFORE, the Town Board of the unincorporated town of Round Mountain, County of Nye, State of Nevada, do ordain:

2.010        ADOPTION.    The unincorporated Town of Round Mountain, County of Nye, State of Nevada, hereby adopts Chapter 484 of NRS by reference, pursuant to NRS 484.777, entitled "Traffic Laws", as if the same were fully set forth herein in detail, with respect to the streets and alleys under its jurisdiction, within the reasonable exercise of its police powers.

2.020        VIOLATION-PENALTY.    Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than six (6) months, or by a fine of not more than ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00), or by both fine and imprisonment.

2.030        JURISDICTION OF JUSTICE OF THE PEACE.    The justice of the peace of Tonopah Township, County of Nye, State of Nevada, shall have jurisdiction over all violations of this ordinance and may render final judgment, hold to bail, fine or commit any offender to the county jail, or may suspend the sentence of any offender pursuant to NRS 4.373.

2.040 FINES AND FEES. Unless otherwise provided by specific statute, all fines and fees collected for violations of this ordinance must be paid to the county treasurer and the county treasurer must distribute such fines and fees to the proper fund of the unincorporated Town of Round Mountain.

2.050 CONSTITUTIONALITY. If any section, clause or phrase of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall continue in full force and effect.

2.060 SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal or unconstitutional, it shall in no way affect the remainder of this ordinance or any section thereof, it being intended that the remainder shall remain in full force and effect.

2.070 REPEAL. Any and all ordinances or regulations or parts of ordinances or regulations of the unincorporated Town of Round Mountain, Nevada, in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

2.080 EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage, approval and
